BASIC CITY ORDINANCE

- 1) It is unlawful to permit any dog to run at large within the municipality. Any dog found upon any public street, side walk, alley, parkway or any unenclosed place shall be deemed running at large unless such dog is firmly held on a leash or is in an enclosed vehicle. For the purpose of this ordinance, noise occurring between the hours of 8:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M. are more disturbing and unnecessary than noises that occur between 7:00 A.M. and 8:00P.M. It is unlawful for any person to be the owner or keeper of any animal or animals which emit noises in such a manner as to materially disturb or annoy a reasonable person.
- 2) The burning of wood, charcoal or propane gas in a gas grill, charcoal grill or similar device for the purpose of cooking food or outdoor burning of wood in a man made or manufactured device, fire ring or in a contained area lined with bricks, stones, rocks or metal in the rear or side yard for cooking, campfire and for other recreational use is permitted. All permitted outdoor burning shall be constantly attended until fire is extinguished. The burning of paper disposed of by general household use shall be permitted in an approved burning container designated and provided for this purpose. Burning of any grass, leaves or any other refuse shall be prohibited. If any complaint is received on any outdoor burning due to the emission of smoke or odors, the police officer on duty will determine if the burning is excessive and have authority to have it immediately extinguished.
- 3) It shall be unlawful to permit any weed, grass or plants other than trees, bushes, flowers, vegetables, or other ornamental plants to grow to a height exceeding eight inches (8") anywhere in the city and any such plants or weeds exceeding such height are declared a nuisance.
- 4) Parking or storing of inoperable or unlicensed motor vehicles and storing or allowing motor vehicle bodies, parts, equipment, motors to remain in open is hereby declared a public nuisance.
- 5) The city has an obligation to clear snow from its streets, and it is impossible to do so with parked vehicles thereon. In the event of a snowfall of two inches (2") or more, or if such snowfall is predicted, all vehicles must be removed from city streets. A \$25.00 fine will be imposed for any

vehicles not in compliance.

6) Depositing of grass/brush into streets is strictly prohibited and will carry a fine of \$75.00.

7) Water service is secured by contacting City Hall between the hours of 7:30 A.M. and 4:30 P.M. Rental tenants must place a \$75.00 security deposit before water service is secured, unless service is paid by the landlord of the property.

8) Brush pick up is held on scheduled days from April through November. A schedule may be obtained at City Hall. All brush less than 24" in length must be tied in bundles and leaves must be bagged and placed at the curb no later than 7:30 A.M. on scheduled days. A specific site is available for disposal of such brush and/or leaves if you wish to transport directly on days not scheduled for pick up. The key for such site is available between 7:30 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. at City Hall.

9) The City has an annual leaf pick up, beginning in October. Leaves must be raked on to the paved portion of the street near the curb.

10) Eureka Lake Pavilion is available for reservation for private events. Information and regulations regarding reservations is available at City Hall. No permit is required for the launching of boats onto Eureka Lake; however gas motors are prohibited. All gas motors must be removed from the boat prior to launch.
