



Eureka is ideally located in Central Illinois between two metropolitan cities: Peoria and Bloomington/Normal both with full service regional airports. The amenities of a larger town are found in Eureka with the full complements of regional cities –shopping centers, cultural opportunities, employers, restaurants, and entertainment. There are three interstate highways with direct routes to Chicago and St Louis.

The City is working with developers to provide additional business opportunities and services to the community and have assisted with the expansion of the West Side Business Park. The City is looking to the future taking a proactive approach to growth and development. The City has recently acquired the option to purchase an additional 100+ acres, demonstrating the City’s commitment for commercial and residential growth.

The 100+ acres is located on State Route 24 on the West side of Eureka. There is rail service running through the parcel with a stop at the Cruger Grain Elevator located just west of the property. City water and sewer run along State Route 24 on the North side and are available. The City water plant was renovated in 1995 and can pump two million gallons of water daily. We are currently operating at half capacity. The waste water treatment plant underwent an upgrade in 1996 giving the city additional processing capabilities. Other utilities available are gas, electric, telephone, DSL, broadband cable with fiber optic running through Eureka.

In addition, West Side Business Park is located along State Route 24: 7 miles from I-74, 20 minutes from Peoria and 25 minutes from Bloomington. The property has access from Route 24 via a turn lane to allow for heavy traffic. There are twelve acres, with water, sewer, electric, gas, and rail service all on site.

We believe Eureka is the best-kept secret in Illinois with amenities not found in other communities its size. Eureka Community Hospital, a part of the BroMen Health Care System, offers a wide range of emergency, surgical, inpatient and outpatient services. Eureka is home to a four-year liberal arts college, Eureka College “Alma mater of President Ronald Reagan.” Eureka has a beautiful 240-acre park with paved and primitive trails through timbered areas, a 36-acre lake, lighted ball diamonds, soccer fields. A community supported Youth and Recreation Program with numerous planned activities.

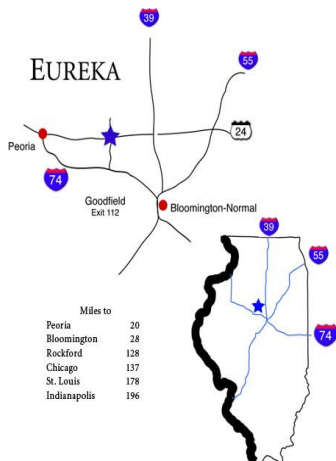
