Runners, golfers and horseshoe pitchers are invited to participate in competitions being held in conjunction with the Eureka sesquicentennial celebration Aug. 20 through 22 at Lake Eureka. All of the competitions will be on Aug. 22 and will include prizes for winners.

A 5K trail race will be at 8 a.m. in the lower park. The \$20 registration fee includes a shirt and breakfast, according to organizer Dave Tapp.

A two-person, nine-hole golf scramble will be from 8 to 11 a.m. at Kaufman Park Golf Course, Route 24 West, Eureka. The \$50 registration fee per team includes greens fees and a cart, according to organizer Bob Gold.
