Come Celebrate 150 Years with us:

The City is holding its 150 year Sesquicentennial Celebration August 20th, 21st and 22nd of 2009. We are combining the Sesquicentennial with the Fine Arts Fair and Eureka Festival. I have attached a short summary of the event for you. The setting for the Fine Arts Fair we feel will provide the atmosphere a Fine Arts Fair demands. “EUREKA 2009 SESQUICENTENNIAL, FINE ARTS FAIR, AND EUREKA FEST”

The Festival will be held at the City of Eureka’s 240-acre park located in the heart of Eureka which includes two and one-half miles of paved walking trails along with several miles of primitive trails winding through the 200-plus acres of beautiful timbered forest. The park also houses two lighted competition ball diamonds, soccer fields, skateboard park, basketball court, and football field not to mention the 36-acre lake great for fishing and several playgrounds and pavilions. Our first annual 2009 Sesquicentennial celebration, Fine Arts Fair, and Eureka Fest will take place on August 20th, 21st and 22nd of 2009 in Eureka’s beautiful 240-acre park with its 36-acre lake.

The Eureka Lake Park has two distinct recreational facilities adjacent to one another. The upper Eureka Lake Park provides a beautiful setting for the Fine Arts Fair overlooking a panoramic view of our picturesque 36-acre lake, a pavilion, and large paved area for the Artists booths with a view of the lake or they can set up in the well-groomed timbered grounds to allow strolling among the Artists displays. A short walk by way of a wide paved trail allows pedestrian and wheel chair access. Ride, walk or use our staircase to the lower park grounds where you will find the City’s many recreational amenities and expansive park grounds which will be used for the 2009 Sesquicentennial and Eureka Festival. This makes Eureka unique, giving us the opportunity to provide a setting appropriate for each venue.

Eureka 2009 Sesquicentennial and Eureka Fest.

The Eureka 2009 Sesquicentennial and Eureka Festival activities will be held in the Eureka Lake Lower Park.

- a. The 2009 Sesquicentennial and Eureka Festival will be the beginning of an annual event for the City of Eureka.
- b. The event will highlight a carnival with 18 rides along with vendors for food, games and inflatable specialties for visitors to enjoy. A large area for crafters has been set aside, fun games for all ages and stage entertainment nightly.
- c. This will be the first carnival for the City in 30 years.
