PARK HOURS: The Park is open from sunrise until 11:00 p.m. FISHING: No fishing shall be allowed in Lake Eureka except with pole and line and it is unlawful to fish with the use of either dead or live minnows for bait. For fishing regulations follow current Illinois DNR regulations. NO ICE SKATING ALLOWED

NO SNOW MOBILES AND ICE BOATS

BOATS: Boating is permitted on the lake from sunrise to sunset only. All water craft must follow current US Coast Guard guidelines/ IL DNR regulations. No gasoline motor operation by un-authorized agencies.

It is unlawful for any watercraft to be used or operated closer than 100 feet from the concrete spillway or closer than 50 feet of any device used for the maintenance of the lake.

MOTOR VEHICLES ARE LIMITED TO 10 MPH
NO FEEDING OF WATERFOWL
NO HORSES ALLOWED IN PARK
