

## **MINUTES OF THE EUREKA CITY COUNCIL MEETING December 18, 2023 – 7:30 p.m.**

The Eureka City Council convened in regular session on December 18, 2023, at 7:30 p.m. Mayor Eric Lind called the meeting to order and after a moment of silence led The Pledge of Allegiance and then directed the City Clerk to call the roll. Present were Aldermen Chambliss, Hasty, Littlejohn, Logan, Teegarden and Wilson. Aldermen Klaus and Williams were absent. Also in attendance were Erik Hasselbacher, Director of Public Works; Pete Logan and Assistant Police Chief Kim Jones.

Moved by Wilson, second by Hasty, to approve the minutes of the December 4, 2023, regular meeting of the City Council. Passed on roll call vote with Aldermen Wilson, Hasty, Chambliss, Littlejohn, Logan and Teegarden all voting Aye.

Moved by Teegarden, second by Hasty, to approve the Treasurer's report for November. Passed on roll call vote with Aldermen Teegarden, Hasty, Chambliss, Littlejohn, Logan and Wilson all voting Aye.

The Mayor asked for public comments on any action to be taken on Agenda items. There were none.

Moved by Chambliss, second by Wilson, to approve and pay the bills as the City's obligation in the amount of \$125,946.50. Passed on roll call vote with Aldermen Chambliss, Wilson, Hasty, Littlejohn, Logan and Teegarden all voting Aye.

Moved by Teegarden, second by Littlejohn, to approve Ordinance 23-17, an ordinance addressing the Paid Leave for All Workers Act. Passed on roll call vote with Aldermen Teegarden, Littlejohn, Chambliss, Hasty, Logan and Wilson all voting Aye.

Moved by Wilson, second by Logan, to approve Ordinance 23-18, an ordinance placing the structure at 302 S. Hilldale out for public bid. Passed on roll call vote with Aldermen Wilson, Logan, Chambliss, Hasty, Littlejohn and Teegarden all voting Aye.

Moved by Teegarden, second by Littlejohn, to approve the annual brush pick-up schedule for 2024. Passed on roll call vote with Aldermen Teegarden, Littlejohn, Chambliss, Hasty, Logan, and Wilson all voting Aye.

Moved by Wilson, second by Hasty, to approve the Annual Meetings list for 2024. Passed on roll call vote with Aldermen Wilson, Hasty, Chambliss, Littlejohn, Logan, and Teegarden all voting Aye.

Moved by Teegarden, second by Wilson, to allow a utility bed installation on the City's 2019 F350 for Maintenance not to exceed \$15,000. Passed on roll call vote with Aldermen Teegarden, Wilson, Chambliss, Hasty, Littlejohn and Logan all voting Aye.


